The Michael Prior Memorial Fund

This fund was established in memory of the much-loved founder of Living Stones, Father Michael Prior. The fund which promotes the development of contextual Palestinian Christian theology and Holy Land Studies is currently supporting a Christian Palestinian student completing his PhD thesis on the situation of the Christian Community in Israel/Palestine. It also sponsors the annual Michael Prior Memorial Lecture.

The Fund for the Bethlehem Home for Abandoned Children

The very young children cared for in this home have been brought to the home by whoever finds them and are cared for by the Daughters of Charity (the Sisters of Saint Vincent de Paul). The children have been abandoned for various reasons, including having been born out of wedlock and abandoned to save family 'honour'. This is an important Christian service to the whole community.

The Mount of Olives Housing Project Fund

The Mount of Olives Housing Project will help to keep Palestinian Christians living in Jerusalem irrespective of their denominational allegiance. It will do this by providing affordable housing units on land owned by the Lutheran World Federation adjacent to the Augusta Victoria Hospital. This project will not only offer hope to many Christian Palestinian families, but will also be a visible reminder to every Jerusalemite that there is hope for a lasting peace.
